

## RECOMMENDATION FOR FURNITURE CLEANING & CARE

BY FOLLOWING UNDERMENTIOND CARE, YOUR FURNITURE CAN AVOID REPAIRS AND LAST FOR YEARS TO COME.

### Do's

#### A. Laminated Surfaces

1.Tables/worktop/storages , Tile(post lam / prelam) , Doors & panels should be clean with colin spray & dry cloth on weekly basis.

#### B. Powder coated Surfaces

1. Frames /components , powder coated tiles , case wall/overhead hamper/powder coated legs /privacy panel should be clean with dry cloth & water or colin spray & dry cloth on weekly basis.

#### C. Fabrics

1. Fabric tiles / panel should be clean with vacuum cleaner /fabric brush or cloth /soft brush on weekly basis.

#### D. General

Always use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth or brush to dust your furniture. Frequent dusting helps protect the finish from unwanted grit and dirt build-up.

Protect furniture from hot serving dishes with a natural fiber table cloth, oven mitt or trivet. Steam from coffeemakers may damage the finish of wooden cabinets. Instead, place coffeemakers on kitchen islands or other open areas.

**Protecting furniture out of direct sunlight** as it can dry out furniture and fade wood surfaces. The heat from the sun can melt finishes and create hard-to-repair cracks.

### Dont's

#### A. Laminated Surfaces

1. Do not use thinner or kerosene.
2. Do not use plastic or metallic scrubber for cleaning.

As a general rule for cleaning wood furniture don't use much water, and when you do, don't leave it on the table for long. Water can cause the wood to warp and crack.

#### B. Powder coated Surfaces

1. Do not use solvents like thinner , kerosene for powder coated surfaces.
2. Do not use pointed tools like knife to remove gum marks or old stickers..

#### C. Fabrics

1. Dirt spot on fabric that are not removed by fabric brush should not be clean with any chemicals. It should be clean with pure petrol only.
